ScottLy: I have just started using Moodle Wiki. I am having trouble importing pictures to my class wiki. Any suggestions?

MichaelM: There are two ways in this wiki

ScottLy: I have noticed that certain pictures/images will work, but not all images import easily.

MichaelM: First, you can use the wiki wizard and click insert image

SusanR: I was trying to embed the code from Kwout ... http://kwout.com/

MichaelM: Or you can copy the image from another page

MichaelM: and change the name. For example

MichaelM: [{Image link = <u>http://helpingstudents.org/JSPWiki/Wiki.jsp?page=WhiteBoard</u>' src = 'Images/whiteboard.png}]

MichaelM: Paste that into your wiki page and you will embed the picture from the images wiki page

ScottLy: I will try that. Thanks

MichaelM: You can create a wiki page and store all your images then simply paste and change the names

ScottLy: Good suggestion!

MichaelM: The example above creates a link to the whiteboard wiki page

MichaelM: You don't have to add the linking. For example [{Image src = 'Images/saving.JPG' }]

MichaelM: Keep in mind that doing it this way, the images have to be attached in the wiki. In this example image files are attached to the images wiki page or

MichaelM: Can be accessed by [Images] in the wiki or <u>http://helpingstudents.org/JSPWiki/Wiki.jsp?page=images</u> from outside the wiki assuming this page is not view protected

ScottLy: What does Wiki WhiteBoard allow you to do?

MichaelM: Draw simple colored lines and create links. Must download Adobe SVG viewer to draw and see the drawing images

MichaelM: The illustration is just a picture of what we tested

MichaelM: It works as soon as you download Adobe SVG image viewer

MichaelM: There is a link to download the Adobe image viewer on the link above

MichaelM: The download is at the bottom of this page link <u>http://www.adobe.com/svg/viewer/install/</u>
